To continue in our efforts in supporting Kyosei, Canon is pleased to announce the new Toner Container Collection Program. Canon recommends that all Canon plastic toner containers be locally recycled or sent to a local energy recovery facility in order to reduce Carbon Dioxide (CO₂) emissions that result from transportation. Since these toner containers are made of only plastic, local recycling and local energy recovery is possible and safe. However, when Canon toner containers are unable to be recycled locally or are unable to be sent to a local energy recovery facility, Canon is asking that customers take responsibility and ship them to the address found below. Canon will assume the responsibility of all costs incurred after the containers are received. Please consider shipping in bulk to help reduce cost and CO₂ emissions.
